#### Huge hit

It only opened at the end of January and already *The Snail and the Chick* is proving a huge hit.

Here's Zoe: "Nature was so healing when recovering from a personal illness, so it was really important in our decision making. We have always had a passion for quality coffee and food and kept talking about how lovely it would be to find a place like this in the forest.

#### **Catering for all tastes**

"Asking ourselves, what would we like to see in nature? We soon provided ourselves with an answer.

"We absolutely love what we are doing now, and we are building up the business in time for what we are hoping will be a bumper spring and summer as it gets warmer.

"We pride ourselves on being environmentally-friendly and our aim is to cater for all tastes, including vegans and vegetarians. We also like to have at least one sweet and savoury gluten free option available too. We use local suppliers for our grass-fed meat and milk, where the cows roam freely. We also offer oat and soya milk alternatives.

#### **Freshly prepared**

"We sell cakes and other savoury refreshments, and our food is all freshly prepared by local suppliers.

"We use *Liquid Spirit* coffee roasters for our bespoke coffee blend and also serve colourful lattes, 100 percent natural teas to include English breakfast and hot chocolates, all made with the finest ingredients.

"At present, we are open Friday, Saturday and Sunday, 9am until 3.30pm and we may be increasing our hours gradually.

### Help is available for men suffering mental issues at Mankind coping strategies and also pay for counselling if that is what's needed.

WHEN a close friend took his own life in 2019, Eastbourne friends Ian Pickard and Paul Roskilly decided they wanted to do something.

Both had experienced their own metal health issues in the past, realising that for men very often it's hard to talk about their problems.

#### Mankind was born.

It started just before the first Lockdown and only one (or two) meetings were held face to face before they transferred to *Zoom*.

lan and Paul haven't looked back.

#### We never judge

Ian said: "Every Wednesday we have a meeting so that people can talk and be listened to.

"It's a completely non-pressure environment, and if people want to stay quiet then they can.

"You can do exactly what you want. Our aim is to help people, and for many the hardest thing is to accept you have a problem.

"It may be anxiety, depression, stress, alcohol, sexuality, something that happened when you were a child, it could be family issues.

"We are here to help. We never judge."

#### In person or virtually

Meetings are held every Wednesday. Some are on *Zoom*, others at *The Old Bank Wellbeing Trust*, the former NatWest in Hampden Park.

Some people prefer to meet in person, others like to be on *Zoom*, where you can remain anonymous.

Ian said: "You can join a meeting but you don't have to say a word if you don't want to. You do what you feel happy doing.

"On average we have between 12 and 20 people per session.

"It's about opening up about how you feel. We listen, talk about "And it's not just people from Eastbourne. Because of being online, we have people from all over the country, and since we started we have helped 89 people.

#### **Great support**

"The Old Bank Wellbeing Trust has been great and at present six of our guys are going there for help and support."

Ian said Lockdown was inevitably difficult for many people's mental health.

"Suddenly, many of us had lost our escape, going to work, meeting a friend or going down the pub.

"It can be very lonely if you are suffering from anxiety or depression. What we provide is safe, friendly and relaxed.

"Many of our clients will typically be late 40s to mid 50s but we have seen younger people lately, some university age.

"We also run a *WhatsApp* group where people can post messages if they are feeling low. This results in other group members replying and often offering reassuring words.

"I know that without our help, some people would not be here now, and that is why what we do is so important.



"And that is also why we want to do more. We are currently looking at opening a light industrial unit in Eastbourne. It will be a coffee shop, where people can come to chat, and also a woodworking shop where people can do meaningful work. It will be self-funding, our guys will make items for sale."

#### **Confidential**

Ian and Paul want to emphasise what they do is 100 per cent confidential, and you can be anonymous if you want to. One person only revealed his identity after six weeks of meetings.

Ian said: "We go round the room, asking people to pitch in, but only if they want to, about how they are coping, and we also look forward to the next seven days as well.

"If people say they are a 10, then that is great, if they are a one then they are absolutely struggling. Five and above is OK.

"There is no charge for coming to us, and we like to think there are suitable options for everyone.

"We never believed it would be so successful, we really do look after each other."

The group needs to fundraise and recently the renowned Pevensey Plungers did a Saturday morning dip to boost funds.

#### And he's only 32.

Now Andrew – an experienced podiatrist – is taking part in a national podiatry campaign running from the 7th–20th March called **#podshealheels** 

Here's Andy: "Very often, people who have heel pain self-diagnose and either buy insoles over the counter which aren't bespoke for them or they just learn to live with the pain.

"Plantar fasciitis is the most common type of heel pain, it is also often misdiagnosed. There are over 30 common causes of heel pain. If pain has been present for more than 2–3 weeks, it is unlikely to be plantar fasciitis."

#### Treatments on offer include:

- Routine nail care.



GHP's Awards aim to recognise the enormous contributions of global organisations and professionals who have provided the best possible care and support within the social care sector, particularly during the incredibly challenging COVID-19 pandemic.

Their awards are highly revered because the awards are based on best industry practice, innovation, leadership, adaptability and overall performance. Nominees must be able to demonstrate their work matches *GHP's* awards criteria and show they have gone above and beyond their duties to deliver excellence in a social care setting.

#### Huge honour

GHP believe that to be nominated for one of their awards is a huge honour. ## 'Flattered' to be CEO at Chaseley

WHEN I left school, I went to university to study business because I wanted to work in a bank.

"It was either going to be a career as an air hostess or work in a bank and I decided to go for the bank and ended up working in London at one of the big multinational banks.

"I realised that I missed the human contact in the work I did. I wasn't speaking with the customers, it was all in front of a screen, so I took myself back to college and trained in care – I did a degree in forensic mental health and care management.

#### **Caring nature**

"I think my interest in care came from my childhood, my dad is a vicar, and my Mum was a nurse, so I grew up in a family that had a very caring nature; so, I threw caution to the wind, left my career in banking, and went to be a domestic in a care home! I wanted to start completely at the bottom.

"I did two days a week at college doing my NVQ's in care management, following on from that I started to work as a chef, then as a carer, then a senior carer, then when I was working with the learning disabilities, I had the wonderful opportunity to become a deputy manager. This gave me a lot of confidence and made me realise I could do things myself.

"So, at a young age of 24, I started running my own home as a registered manager and I absolutely loved it! For me, I feel that so much emphasis goes on when we come into the world with much celebration and so much love, yet when we leave the world, it's very much not talked about, very hush, hush. I wanted to make a difference as to how we leave the world, still with as much love and celebration.

#### The Chaseley Trust

"I worked as a registered manager, regional manager, compliance director, all different kinds of roles within the care sector for the next fifteen years. I was contacted by *The* 





*Chaseley Trust* in 2020 to see if when the current CEO retired if I would be interested in taking over.

"I was and still am incredibly flattered to be in this role, so in February 2021 I joined *The Chaseley Trust* as CEO.

"It's a trust, and a charity that really empowers you, it really gets under your skin. The client group that we work with predominantly are adults with progressive neurological conditions, such as Huntington's, Multiple Sclerosis, Parkinson's, Stroke, but we also care for members of the community that have had accidents, through no fault of their own that have left them with a permanent brain injury. So, we work a lot with rehabilitation to enable people to get back out into the community to live their lives as best as they can considering their injuries.

#### An honour

"It can be misunderstood that just one tiny thing that you do, that you can take for granted might have such a huge impact on their lives, there's a lot of restrictions they have on things that we do automatically in our day-to-day, that they have to work hard to achieve. If I can get a smile or a laugh from someone in one day, then I'll go home happy. We have the most vivacious characters with the biggest dreams and my role is to make sure those dreams still happen, I find it an honour to be here! "We've just celebrated our 75th year and are looking at how we're going to be here for the next 75 years.

"It's been tough for the care sector through the pandemic and a lot of companies have struggled immensely throughout this period. Our plan is to completely refurbish this beautiful building over the next fifteen years to make sure that the building is here for another 75 years, enabling us to grow.

#### **Drive and passion**

"That's part of the plan, but also, we plan to develop our therapy service team and expand more into the community, in respective areas of care that are currently not covered in this area of Eastbourne and East Sussex. So that's still in development, but for me, it's looking at whether we can assist more with paediatric care.

Personally speaking, I know friends and family that have had to travel to Kent or out of the area to get that level of care that their youngsters need.

"It's unlike anywhere I've ever worked before and I absolutely love it, and I feel so privileged to have this role and be here, I'm also lucky to have the most incredible team of staff, that have as much drive and passion as I do."





Jamie said: "We are a proper beer shop selling craft beers, wines, and non-alcohol drinks. We have around 200 craft beers and some lovely Belgian beers.




"Most of our drinks are sourced locally, which is very important to us. For example, four of our taps are from local breweries.







# Green and pleasant

MARCH is the official beginning of spring but it can still be very cold at times, so keep an eye on the weather forecast and wait to do jobs if conditions aren't quite right. The clocks also go forward on the 27th of the month, so the lengthening daylight hours will help plants to really get growing. Spring bulbs start to take centre stage in the borders and in patio pots, rewarding your efforts for planting them last autumn.

If you are into growing vegetables, now is the time to get seeds started in the greenhouse, and you can sow hardy seeds straight outdoors into their final positions. It's also time to kickstart your flower displays. Start sowing flower seeds undercover to enjoy colourful displays come summer.

#### Bulbs take centre stage!

This is the month when any spring bulbs we planted last autumn really take centre stage in our gardens. I suppose the main ones we all like to plant and grow are tulips, daffodils, crocus and hyacinths. I have quite a few of each at *Driftwood*, the stunning hyacinths in the header are in my garden now. I have a over 30 containers planted with spring bulbs and many planted directly in the ground too. The great advantage of having them planted in a container means you can move the pot and place that fabulous splash of colour anywhere in the garden to maximum effect! Then, as the flowers die back, move the pot back to a less eye-catching spot.

Alternatively, if you adopt the lasagne method of bulb planting, which involves planting layers of bulbs in pots, just like making lasagne, the result is a pot crammed with wave after wave of spring flowers, giving you colour right through spring. To achieve this, place the latest-flowering bulbs at the bottom of the pot, with layers of earlier-flowering bulbs above them.

#### **National Garden Scheme**

This year sees the welcome return to the scheme of a beautiful plants woman's garden in Arlington. Opening for the first time, at this time of year, is *Bates Green* in Tye Hill Road, Arlington, BN26 6SH. The plot is a 1.5-acre tranquil space with a woodland garden created around a majestic oak tree with courtyard gardens and seasonal container displays. The front garden is a winter and spring joy with narcissi, primroses, violets, early tulips and coloured stems of cornus and salix.

This garden has been owned by the McCutchan family since 1921 and was developed and skillfully planted by Carolyn McCutchan when she moved to the property in 1968. The garden was renowned for its colourful imaginative planting and *Bates Green* has featured in many magazine articles. Since Carolyn's death in 2019, the garden has been undergoing a period of restoration by a small team of gardeners led by Emma Reece who was a student of Carolyn's in 2002.

Pre-booking is essential for its only March date, Sunday 20th from 10:30am to 4:00pm, when refreshments and light lunches will be available too. Entry will be £6 for adults and £3 for children and you must buy your tickets at **www.ngs.org.uk** 

#### Mother's Day 2022

This year the day the clocks go back and Mother's Day both fall on the same day, Sunday 27th March. In the UK and across the world the favoured gift for Mothers always seems to be a bouquet of flowers or a pot plant. We're told that the pink carnation specifically represents a mother's love, but white, which symbolizes pure or unconditional love and good luck, is another good choice. As a bonus, carnations are one of the longer lasting cut flowers that you can buy, which means your gift will last. It's all down to personal choice, my mother is not a lover of carnations and I tend to buy her favourite which are freesias. It seems the top five chosen for Mum each year are tulips, roses, peonies, carnations and orchids. Take your pick and buy what you think your Mum will enjoy!

Spring perennials for March

Here are three lovely perennials for this time of year, all of which I have in my own garden.

The first is Pulsatilla, this delightful little hardy perennial is perfect for filling gaps in rockeries and gravel gardens. From late March to May, Pulsatilla vulgaris produces bright purple flowers above clumps of finely dissected, downy foliage. Attractive, furry seed heads replace the flowers as they fade, extending the season of interest into summer. Best grown where it can be left to establish without disturbance, and it will seed about to create spreading groups.

The second, Hellebore Argutifolius, pale green flowers hang above leathery, prickly-edged, sea-green leaves from January to March. This popular evergreen, Corsican hellebore makes an architectural statement in the middle of a mixed or shrub border, its handsome foliage is a long-lasting source of interest after the flowers have passed.

The third is Bergenia, commonly known as elephant's ears, because of their large, leathery, oval leaves. They are low maintenance, evergreen, will grow in sun or shade and tolerate a wide range of soils, including dry soils and clay.
